**DAY 1: TAIPEI ARRIVAL**

Welcome to Taiwan, after immigration and custom formality, you will be met and transfer to hotel by private car.  
Acc: Riviera Hotel (4 stars)

**DAY 2: TAIPEI CITY TOUR WITH NATIONAL PALACE MUSEUM**

Breakfast at hotel, Your tour today will include the Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall, The Presidential Office (Pass by), The Grand Hotel (Photo stop), The Martyrs' Shrine and final stop at the National Palace Museum. Balance of the day is at leisure. Evening on your own to visit the Night Market.

**DAY 3: TAIPEI DEPARTURE**

After breakfast at hotel, transfer to airport for your onward flight

**DAY 1: TAIPEI/SUN MOON LAKE**

Pick up from hotel in Taipei tour to the beautiful Sun Moon Lake with a round-Lake Tour by bus. Tour continue to Ita Thao Indigenous Village – Ci'en Pagoda – Xuanzhuang Temple – Wenwu Temple)  
Acc: Fleur de Chine Hotel, (5-star)

**DAY 2: SUN MOON LAKE/KAOHSIUNG**

After breakfast at hotel, tour to Fo Guang Shan via Xiangshan Visitor Center in Kaohsiung, evening visit to the popular Liuhe Tourist Night Market  
Acc: Grand Hi Lai Hotel, (5-star)

**DAY 3: KAOHSIUNG/KENTING/TAITUNG**

After breakfast at hotel, tour to Kenting National Park, Taitung (Chihpen Hot Spring Bath), Maobitou, Chuanfan (Sail) Rock, Eluanbi Park (lighthouse), Longpan Park and arrive at Taitung  
Acc: Hotel Royal Chihpen, (5-star)

**DAY 4: TAITUNG/EAST COAST NATIONAL SCENIC AREA/HUALIEN**

After breakfast at hotel, departure for the East Coast National Scenic Area to include Xiaoyeliu, Sanxiantai, Shitiping, Fanshuliao), Marble Factory and Exhibition Hall  
Acc: Silks Place Taroko, Hualien (5-star)

**DAY 5: HUALIEN/TOROKO GORGE/TAIPEI**

After breakfast at hotel, tour the one of the most beautiful Gorges in the world - Toroko Gorge, your tour including visit to the Cihmu Bridge, Shakadang Trail, Lushui Trail, Eternal Spring Shrine, Swallow Grotto) – Qingshui Cliff and back to Taipei. (Tour ends)

The enchanting Taiwan circle island tour features the most beautiful part of Taiwan, this tour will offer you from the north to the south of the beautiful formosa island. Visiting the beautiful Toroko Gorge to the enchanting Sun Moon Lake, to the south of Kenting National Park, our package include daily American breakfast at hotel, carefully selected hotels throughout. Come aboard with us, we will show you our beautiful island of Taiwan.

**DAY 1: ARRIVAL TAIPEI**

Upon arrival at Taoyuan International Airport (TPE), you will be met and transferred to your hotel by private car. The remainder of the day will be free.

**DAY 2: HALF DAY TAIPEI CITY TOUR**

Our first stop is Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall, an impressive monument in memory of President Chiang Kai-shek. After that, we will depart to the Grand Hotel Taipei and have a photo stop. This 5-star hotel is another historical landmark. On the way to the Grand Hotel, our guide will have a quick introduce when we pass by Presidential Office Building, a symbolic landmark and historical site in Taipei City. After the photo stop, we will depart to Martyrs' Shrine. The highlight of this place is guard changing ceremony. Our last stop is the world-famous National Palace Museum, which has a collection of nearly 700,000 pieces of ancient Chinese artifacts and artworks throughout 8,000 years of Chinese art over multiple dynasties.

**DAY 3: TAIPEI / SUN MOON LAKE + NATURE HOT SPRING**

To be picked up at lobby of hotel in Taipei City, we will drive to Sun Moon Lake which is located in the middle of Taiwan and situated 762 meters above sea level in the lofty mountains of Central Taiwan. Tour will stop at the famous Wenwu Temple, also known as Literature-Warrior Temple, dedicated to Confucius as Master of Pen and to Kuan Ti as Master of Sword, Ita Thao Indigenous Village, Xuanzhuang Temple and Ci En Pagoda. After touring round Sun Moon Lake, check in hotel. *Enjoy natural hot spring at the Fleur de Chine Hotel, Sun Moon Lake.*  
(You can also enjoy the walking trails, biking, hiking or boating at the lake.)

**DAY 4: SUN MOON LAKE / FO GUANG SHAN MONASTERY/KAOHSIUNG**

Check out hotel, we will stop by Xiangshan Visitor Center before driving to Fo Guang Shan Buddhist Monastery, the most famous Buddhist sacred place of southern Taiwan. Here you will learn about Buddhism during the monastery walking tour and communicate with some of the monks or nuns during the visit. Continuously, we will drive to Kaohsiung which is the second largest city of Taiwan. The tour will take you to Love River and Liuhe Night Market. Overnight stay at Kaohsiung.

**DAY 5: KAOHSIUNG / KENTING / CHIHPEN HOT SPRINGS, TAITUNG**

Morning tour to Kenting National Park, located at Taiwan's southern tip and the 37 miles of coral-rimmed shoreline along three sides of the park provide its main attractions. Stops will be made at Eluanbi lighthouse, Maobitou, Chuanfan(sail) Rock and Longpan Park. Continuously we will drive to Taitung via Southern Link Highway. Overnight stay at Chihpen.  
(Enjoy natural hot spring at Hotel Royal Chihpen)

**DAY 6: TAITUNG / EAST COAST NATIONAL SCENIC AREA/HUALIEN**

After breakfast, it will be an exciting East Coast Tour. The East Coast National Scenic Area, known as "Taiwan's last unspoiled land", stretches 170 kilometers down the east coast of the island. Weathering, erosion, and accumulation have produced a wide range of landforms here. Our tour will stop at Xiaoyeliu, Sanxiantai, Shitiping (Stone Steps), Fanshuliao marble factory and the exhibition hall. Late afternoon, we will proceed to Hualien for overnight stay at Taroko National Park.

**DAY 7: HUALIEN / TAROKO GORGE / QINGSHUI CLIFF/TAIPEI**

After breakfast, we will make a visit to Taroko National Park. Taroko Gorge is an exceptionally beautiful, narrow ravine created by the Liwu river which has cut deep into the mountains of solid marble. A road carved into sheer walls of rock rewinding its way past forested peaks and cliffs towering thousands of feet above it, while hundreds of feet below a river roars past gigantic marble boulders. Stops will be made at Taroko Gorge Gateway, Shakadang Trail or Lushui Trail, Swallow Grotto, Cihmu Bridge and Changchun Temple (Eternal Spring Shrine). We will then drive back to Taipei with a stop at Qingshui Cliff, drive through Syue-Shan Long Tunnel (12.9 Kms) to arrive at around 6 PM.

**DAY 8: DEPARTURE**

At leisure until check out and you will be transferred to airport for departure flight by private car (NO guide).

## FANTASTIC TOUR ITINERARY

### DAY 01 Taipei

Upon arrival Taipei, Taiwan and after immigration and custom formality, you will be greeted by our local representative and transfer to Taipei with private car (Driver only). Check in at hotel for a well deserved rest.

### DAY 02 Taipei city tour (B)

Enjoy breakfast at hotel, your tour will begin for the visit to Presidential Office (Pass by) – Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall – The Grand Hotel (Photo stop) - Martyrs' Shrine – National Palace Museum.

#### “ National Palace Museum “

The National Palace Museum has a permanent collection of nearly 700,000 pieces of Chinese artifacts and artworks, making it one of the largest of its type in the world. The collection encompasses items spanning 8,000 years of Chinese history from the neolithic age to the modern period.[3] Most of the collection are high quality pieces collected by Chinese emperors. The National Palace Museum shares its roots with the Palace Museum in the Forbidden City of Beijing, whose extensive collection of artwork and artifacts were built upon the imperial collections of the Ming and Qing dynasties.

### DAY 03 Jiufen Village and Northeast Coast Tour (B)

Morning free at leisure, afternoon tour to Jiufen, Northeast coast of Taiwan, where you will visit Nanya Natural Rock Formations- Bay of Two Colors (pass by)-Jinguashi Remains of the 13 Levels (photo stop)- Jiufen Village.

#### “ Jiufen Village “

Jiufen used to be the center of gold mining. It is located within the hills in northeast of Taiwan. The village is next to the mountain and facing the sea. In 1890, someone struck gold near Jiufen. The poor village soon attracted prospectors of 4,000 families. The village once was gold city of Asia and called little Shanghai or little Hong Kong. However, with the decline of gold mining activities, Jiufen fades. Later, several movies chose to shoot here and the movies won international acknowledgement. For example, the film "A City of Sadness" has won first prize in Venice Film Festival and awakened people's memory of Jiufen. It seems that the prosperous old streets, buildings, mines and the glamorous gold digging days are flashing before our eyes. The place is whispering its golden past. Now, there are many unique teahouses in Jiufen. These teahouses are best stops during visit to this mountain village. Also, there is the beautiful ocean view of Keelung outer sea.

### DAY 04 Toroko (Marble) Gorge (B)

After breakfast at hotel, today you will visit one of the most beautiful Gorge in Taiwan, the Toroko Gorge, your will visit Taroko Gorge (marble gorge) – Shakadang Trail – Swallow Grotto – Cihnu Bridge – Tianxiang –Lunch- Tunnel of Nine Turns- Eternal Spring Shrine– Transfer from Hualien to Taipei– Return to Hotel.

#### “ Toroko (Marble) Gorge “

Taroko became a national park in 1986, including Hualien City, Nantou County and Taichung City. Taroko is famous for its spectacular mountains and marble canyons. Cliffs and canyons stretch along Liwu River. Four million years ago, the island of Taiwan was formed by the collision of plates. After millions of years of wind erosion, the marble rocks were exposed and cut by Liwu River, creating impressive grand canyons. From Qingshui to Nanhu Peak, the drop height is 3,742 meters. Such special geography has also bred special flora and fauna in this area.

### DAY 05 Taipei (B)

Breakfast at hotel, free at leisure until time for departure to the airport as you leave this beautiful formosa island to return to your homeland or onward to your next destination.
